2022-2023 School Supply List for Crossroads Academy

Students will be allowed to have backpacks this year.

On the first day of school, students will be given an agenda book and a communicator folder. The communicator folder is to help your child streamline information to and from school. Graded papers in the “Keep at Home” pocket should be removed daily and kept at home. The “Return to School” pocket should have homework and signed forms and documents that need to be turned in to school.

The following are your child’s personal items that will be used for his/her classes. These materials will need to be brought to class daily. Please make sure his/her name is written on these materials. All uniform shirts and jackets should also be labeled with your child’s name. Items that are still in good shape from last year may be reused.

- (1) pencil/highlighter zippered pouch or case (we will distribute pencils and highlighters to the students) This item should not leave campus – it should stay in your child’s cubby/locker.
- (4) spiral notebooks
- (2) composition notebooks
- (1) Headphones or earbuds -All students taking FLVS courses **must** have headphones or earbuds. All students need them for testing throughout the year.

For Math Class:

- (1) Scientific Calculator (TI-30X or TI-34 by Texas Instruments) – **It must be a NON-GRAPHING calculator.**
- (1) protractor
- (1) compass
- (1) ruler
- (3) spiral notebooks for math notes
